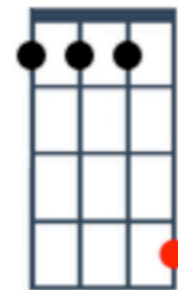
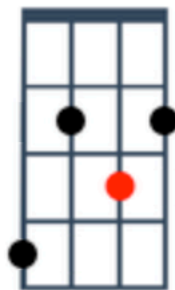
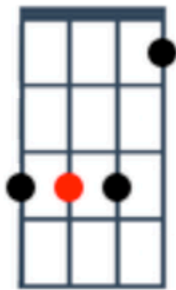
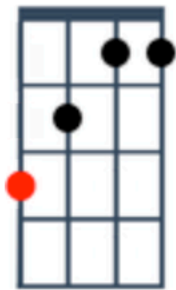




Movable chords are closed position voicings that provide the ability to play in various keys. The chord name is based on the root, shown as a red dot.
